


## POT-POURRI

This project sheet shows a bowl-shaped pot-pourri with no decorations. A wide variety of chisels, scrapers or hollowers may be used for this project - use the tools of your choice.




Mount the wood with the side that will become the top towards the head.

Read the Basics Sheets for mounting options.

Round the block off and make a dovetail or spigot for re-mounting.

Shape the outside.


Finishing cuts should be downhill for the best finish.



Re-mount the wood with the foot towards the head.


A hole drilled down the centre will make hollowing easier. If the outer edge of this hole does not exceed about 70mm you will be able to use this edge for later remounting to finish the foot of the pot-pourri.

Cut a shallow ledge to fit the pot-pourri lid.



Hollow the inside. This does not have to be thin-walled or a fine finish as the completed work will be filled with pot-pourri mix. But it is good practice to do the job well.

Sand and finish the outside.



Turn the work over and clean the bottom. Finish the outside completely.
